The governors are delighted with the work that has been undertaken on the school playground.

The work has been partly funded from the school's capital budget but a large sum was provided to the school by ODST who, following petition by staff and governors, recognised the health and safety concerns raised by the former playground surface.

Over the half term holiday lines will be drawn on the new surface. Governors are very grateful to The Friends for funding this work.

Over the summer, Astro Turf will be placed on the slope at the back of the playground, which will reduce the amount of mud that currently runs off the school field.



During the last two weeks of term groups of children from every class are being asked what it is like to be a pupil at The Blake School.

The children have also been asked what they think would make the school an even better place and their views will feed into the school's plans for development, alongside those of parents.
