# Year 6 Secondary School Transfer Reminder:

If you have not yet applied for your child's secondary school place, please may we remind you that the closing date is Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> October.

### <u>Quinta:</u>

#### Medication in School:

If your child keeps medication in school, e.g. an inhaler or epi pen, please may we remind you to complete a *Parental Agreement for School to Administer Medicine* form at the beginning of each academic year. Please could you ensure that your child's medication is in date and that you take home any medication that is no longer needed in school. A copy of the agreement can be found on our website, together with the school's *Administering Medicine Policy*, or you can ask for a copy from the school office.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you very much for having us in school to do Bikeability with your children. It is wonderful to see the Year 6 children again and spend 8 hours cycling on local roads with them. We also met Year 5 for the first time for a 2-hour fun packed playground session. We hope the children enjoyed it as much as we did; they should be very proud of gaining the skills and confidence to ride safely on the roads. As well as running Bikeability in 16 schools in West Oxfordshire, we have a bicycle workshop on Corn Street. At the workshop, volunteers from all walks of life help us to recondition donated bikes – some of which are given to people who need one (including some children who do Bikeability) and others are sold to cover our costs.

We have been selected as one of three projects in the Tesco Bags for Life programme. Throughout November and December 2018, if you make a purchase in a local Tesco (including Cogges), you can take a token to vote. Please consider voting for us. If we win, we will be able to expand our Build-a-bike programme. By helping young people with additional needs to build a bike, they gain skills and confidence, as well as the means to get to shops, social centres and employment.

You can also help by donating any bikes you no longer need and by coming to the project for all your bike repair needs – we do repairs and servicing at competitive prices.
