# THE BLAKE SCHOOL ADVENTURE ZONE

The Blake School, in response to feedback from pupils and staff, educational research and best practice, seeks to raise enough money to build an adventure zone in the current wooded area.

This will consist of a solid rubberized floor with equipment aimed at both younger and older children, together with a variety of play and strength training facilities, i.e. monkey bars at different heights, slack lining zones, rope walks/low ropes, etc.

It will be built with the specific aims of:

- A) **Building children's strength** research has shown that upper body exercises, which encourage grip strength, improve children's handwriting skills.
- B) **Building children's resilience** and capacity to face and overcome challenges.
- C) **Bringing a sense of fun and engaging play** happy playtimes lead to happy children and happy classrooms.

The project is expected to cost in the region of £30,000 – £35,000. We currently have approx £10,000 in the pot from fundraising already undertaken, and hope to secure the remaining funds over the course of this academic year.
