School Development Plan

Governors are continuing to monitor the 17/18 school development plan and a number of governors have visited school over the past term, their reports have been discussed by the governors.

The governors, having considered the feedback from the surveys spent some time considering possible objectives for the School Development Plan for 18/19.

At their recent meeting the governors discussed the draft plan, which had been prepared for them by the Senior Leadership Team and will be finalised next term.

The Budget

Governors are responsible for overseeing the financial performance of the school and ensuring its funds are well spent.

During May governors have to agree a budget for the next academic year.

School budgets are under increasing pressure and governors are aware of the challenges that this presents to the school.

A balanced budget has been submitted to ODST who have financial oversight for the school and who also provide financial help and advice to the school business manager as she carries out her role.

This term the governors have been supported in their work by a National Leader of Governance, Mark A' Bear.

Mark has been offering advice and support particularly to the Chair and Vice-Chair of Governors.

Annual survey

The governors were delighted that so many parents/carers took the opportunity to share their views by completing the annual survey.

A summary of the results was shared in the April Governor newsletter.

The governors discussed the feedback from the survey at their April meeting and noted suggestions made for future school improvement when discussing priorities for next year.

Governors also discussed the feedback from the annual staff survey, which they found very informative.

Governors have discussed, amended and approved the following documents –
