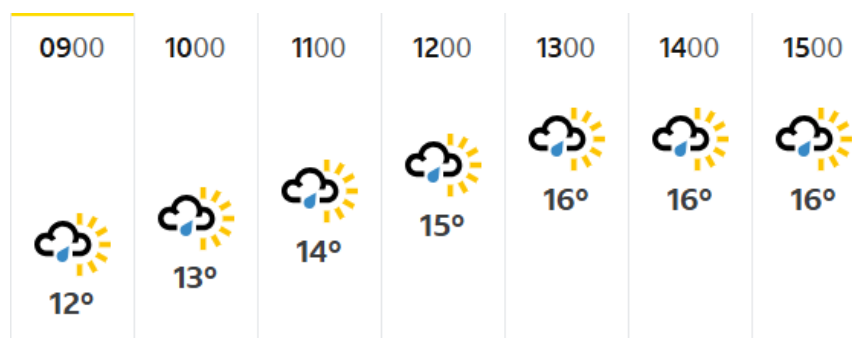
News from Mr Edwards-Grundy

Please make sure that your children are wearing the correct uniform to school and that everything is clearly labelled. We lose lots of unnamed items every day!

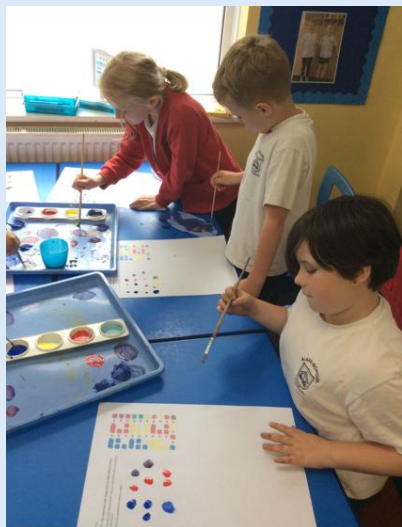
PE kit should be black shorts, (not grey and not football shorts) and a plain white T-shirt, (not coloured and no logos and no football tops).
