Please may we remind you that, unless it is an extreme emergency, details of any alternative arrangements about collecting your child at the end of the school day, should be given to your child's teacher or teaching assistant when you drop them off in the morning. # Operation Christmas Child Shoe Boxes:

If you would like to fill a shoe box but do not already have an empty one, Operation Christmas Child have produced their own boxes that do not need to be covered; we have some available in school at a nominal cost of 20p each. If you are unsure which age to pack a box for, we suggest you choose either 2-4 years or 10-14 years, as there are always fewer boxes packed for these children. Further leaflets are available from the school office so, if you know neighbours, friends or other family members who may be interested, please pick up a leaflet for them. Filled boxes can be brought into school from now until the morning of Friday 17th November.



### Poppies:

Once again this year we are supporting the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal. As usual, children will be able to buy a poppy in class for a small donation. This year we also have available from the school office friendship bracelets and snap bands \*at £1 each, wristbands and poppy reflectors at 50p each. If your child would like to purchase any of these additional items, please send the money to school in a sealed envelope labelled with your child's name, class and which item/s they would like. Please be aware that we only have a limited stock of these items.

\*Please note that snap bands must be taken home on the day of purchase and not kept in school.



### Medication in School:

If your child keeps medication in school, e.g. an inhaler or epipen, please may we remind you to complete a Parental Agreement for School to Administer Medicine form at the beginning of each academic year. Please may we ask you to ensure that your child's medication is in date and that you take home any medication that is no longer needed in school. A copy of the agreement can be found on our website together with the school's Administering Medicine Policy or you can ask for a copy from the school office.


