School Development Plan

Governors have been into school during this term to carry out monitoring visits looking at the school's progress against the development priorities.

Visits have focussed on the role of the SENCO, metacognition, outdoor provision, year group reviews and how the school's vision is reflected in policies.

Governors are deeply appreciative of the time that staff give to them when they visit.

Safeguarding

Every year the governors must complete an Annual Safeguarding Report, which is produced by the Local Authority. The report requires governors to check every aspect of the school's safeguarding procedures and practice to ensure that they are robust. Anthony Sayles, the school's safeguarding governor, has also carried out a monitoring visit.

Maths and History

The Governors have been delighted to welcome Miss Claire Main (Maths), and Miss Debbie Robertson and Mrs Laura Rump (History) to their recent meetings.

Governors found the detailed information presented by the members of staff both interesting and informative.

The attendance of staff members at their meetings means that all governors have the opportunity to ask questions and to increase their understanding of the current curriculum provision.
