## The Hedgehog Club at Deer Park Wood: *fun and learning in the woods*



Each session runs every Friday during term time, from 10am - 12 noon, and includes hot chocolate and a biscuit, as well as hot drinks for the adults. It is open to all pre-school age children at a cost of £7 per child over 6 months of age and £6 for siblings. (If you sign up for a term and pay in advance you only pay £6 per session!)

### **What is it?**

The Hedgehog Club is based on the principles of Forest School, where the children learn by playing and exploring their natural environment. This approach helps children become more independent and develops their social and physical skills. The activities are led by what the children are interested in and are not directed by the adults. By signing up to a term at a time you are allowing your children to build on their learning from week to week. They will gain confidence in the surroundings and develop a relationship with the natural world. For more information about Forest School and the benefits to children, please see

The activities will take place at Deer Park Wood opposite the Deer Park Estate in Witney. Your child will be able to:

- Climb trees

- Make things from sticks
- Play in the mud kitchen
- And go wherever their imagination takes them....
