101 parents/carers completed the annual survey in February 2019, representing 137 children.

One of the areas of concern raised by a number of parents related to the consistency of behaviour management across the school. This has been something that has been the subject of recent staff meetings and the school's behaviour policy is currently being revised.

We are encouraged that the number of 'red card' incidents has reduced by 29% since September 2019, compared to the same period last year and are confident that training and new strategies will further reduce this.
