Over the past couple of weeks we have had a significant number of concerns raised about the behaviour of children online.


We would like to remind you that your children are never too young for you to start having conversations with them about both staying safe online and appropriate online behaviours.

What happens online is impossible for us to monitor or untangle in school. As parents we strongly urge you to talk with your children about their online behaviours and to put in place boundaries to help them limit their usage.

Where we have evidence that social media or gaming platforms are being used inappropriately, offensively or to target other children, our behaviour policy enables us to enforce the same sanctions as we would if the behaviours happened in school.
