### School lunches

## Covid-19

As expected, in line with the national data, we have today been made aware that a number of your children have tested positive for Covid-19 over the break.

Although the guidance is due to change next week, currently all individuals who test positive on a LFD test, whether or not they are symptomatic, are expected to go for a confirmatory PCR test.
