

Use of Internet Acceptable Use Policy for Pupils





I know that I must use all electronic devices safely

- I know that my parents/carers can see and check what I do on any electronic device.
- I will treat my username and password like my toothbrush - I will not let anyone else use it, and I will not use theirs.
- I will be aware of my personal safety when I am communicating online, and will not share personal information about myself or others.
- I will tell a teacher or my parent/carer immediately about any nasty or inappropriate material or messages I see online or on social media, or anything that makes me feel uncomfortable when I see it.
- I understand that school will look after me and my classmates and can help if anything happens online - even if I am using an electronic device at home.

I know that I must respect others when I am online/using social media

- I will always treat others the same way I would want them to treat me - just as I would when not online. I will not use the internet/ social media to be unkind or bully anyone.
- I will be polite online, and I will not use strong, aggressive, or inappropriate language. I appreciate that others may have different opinions.
- I will not take or share pictures or videos of anyone without their permission.

You should:

-  Keep your username and password secret.
-  Always be polite when you send messages to other users.
-  Only use the chat function on Teams to send messages relating to school.
-  Always tell your teacher, or someone you live with if you see, hear or read anything which makes you feel uncomfortable whilst online/using social media.

You should not:

-  Send anyone a message which is not nice.  Use unkind words in a message.
-  Use any other person's login details.  Use any other person's work.
-  Use any chat or messaging functions to make anybody else's learning harder.
-  Tell someone you have never met any of the following information:
 - your name
 - your home address or telephone numbers
 - any other personal information about yourself or any of your friends.
