#### Maths

Learning Focus: I can add two numbers together. I can count on from a number.

Ask a grown up to put some objects (up to 5 things initially) in a box/tub/plastic cup etc. Count them as they are put in. Cover the objects, so you can no longer see them. Put 1-5 objects outside of the box. Can you find out how many objects there are altogether by counting on from the number of objects in the box.

#### For example:

Put 4 lego bricks inside a box. Cover them up. Put 3 lego bricks outside of the box.

Now you need to count how many there are altogether. You count on from the number of bricks that are hiding in the box - even though you can't see them!

Touch each of the bricks that are outside of the box as you count, 4.....5,6,7

The total is 7. Can you complete a cherry model to represent what you have done? What would the first part be? (4) What would the second part be? (3) What is the whole, or total? (7)

Can you write a number sentence to represent this too?

Repeat by changing the quantities each time.
