Please send your money into school in a named envelope no later than **tomorrow (Thursday)** morning.

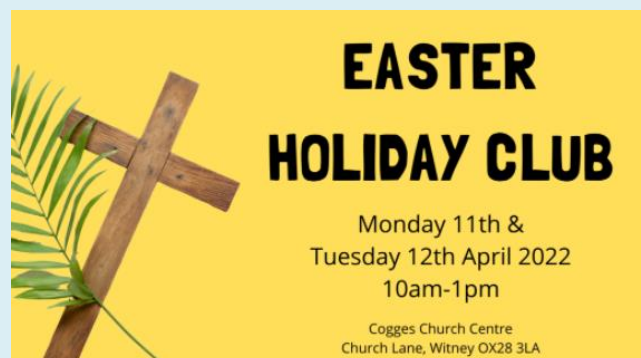
## Holiday club at St Mary's Cogges

Holidays should be taken during school holiday times – any holidays taken during school time will be unauthorised.

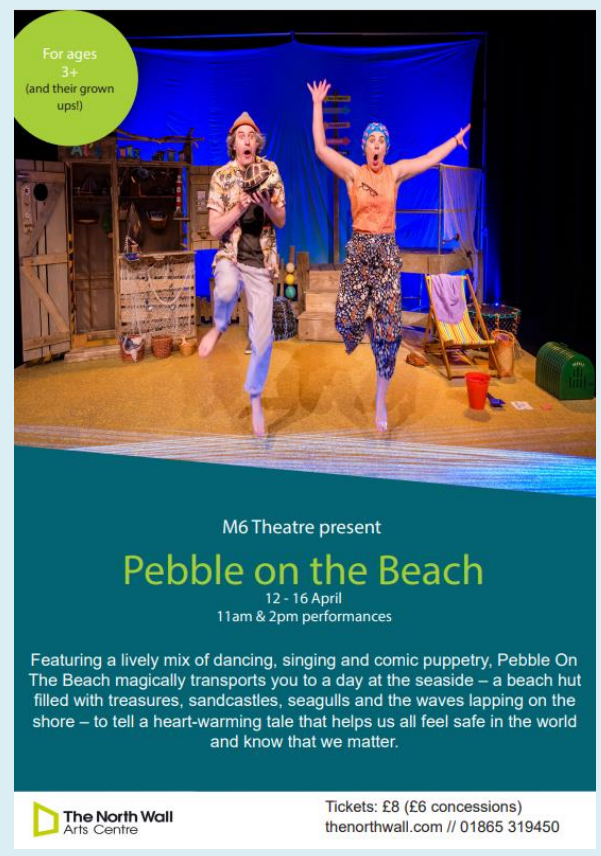

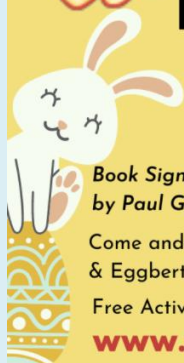
