## **Pupil Outcomes**

The Department for Education produces an annual report detailing the school's outcomes, including comparison with the national picture.

Whilst recognising where challenges remain, the governors were delighted to see the school's three-year positive improvement in statutory data outcomes. Statutory outcomes show that children at this school are achieving broadly in line with children nationally and many are making better progress than other children nationally.

## **Finance**

Governors spent some time reflecting on the school's current financial situation including reviewing the Year End outturn.

All schools continue to be challenged by the real terms cut to funding. Meticulous monitoring and making savings wherever possible has however ensured that the school's current position remains positive.

#### **Behaviour**

Governors have reviewed and analysed the number of red cards being given out at playtimes for poor behaviour.

Behaviour at the school is overwhelmingly positive, both in the classroom and at playtimes. Where children are struggling with behaviour, a range of support strategies are in place.

# **Early Years**

Governors were delighted to read the annual report from the Early Years team. The report detailed the amazing work that is taking place across the two classes, ensuring that children at The Blake School receive a really high-quality start to their time at the school.

### **Special Educational Needs**

Rebecca Patchett (SENCO), provided a detailed report to the governors regarding provision across the school for children with Special Educational Needs.

Governors are delighted that so many children with additional needs are able to flourish within the school and noted the commitment of all staff in ensuring appropriate provision is in place.

Governors recognised that high quality teaching benefits all children, but also noted the invaluable work of the TA team in supporting children who require additional help or resource.
