## Road safety

Footsteps is a child pedestrian Road Safety scheme aimed at parents and their children.

Rather than telling children when and how to be safe when walking and crossing roads, the programme encourages you to ask your children open-ended questions and help them think about the decisions they are making.

We would like to remind everyone that the speed limit in front of the school and in all of the surrounding roads is now 20mph. For everyone's safety, please do stick to this limit.

The car park is very large, but there is not room for everyone at once. Please walk, cycle or scoot to school if you can. If you have to come in a car, please be patient and do not use the surrounding roads or the staff car park. Thank you.

## Cogges Manor Farm

Cogges Manor Farm springs to life and opens for a new season from Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> February.

You can visit and say hello to the friendly farmyard animals, have a go on the adventure play and find minibeasts with the Cogges Explorer bug pots and ID guides. There are 17 acres of open space to explore and create your own adventure.

The manor house, walled garden, kitchen café and gift shop are all now open. You don't need a ticket to visit the café or the gift shop. The café opens at 9am, with the farm opening at 9.30am. The café closes at 3.30pm, the farm at 4pm.

The large car park is open during the farm's opening hours. During term time, it is locked by 6pm as we have use of it until the end of our After School Provision. Unless there is a school event (performance or parents' evenings), if you park in the car park after 6pm, you will regrettably be locked in until the following morning.
